**YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED** that there is now pending in the Superior Court of California for the County of Los Angeles a legal case (“the Litigation”) on behalf of all persons who fit the below detailed description.

This Notice is provided for the purpose of informing you about the Litigation, the Court’s decision allowing the case to proceed as a class action, your right to remain a part of the class and your right to exclude yourself from the class.

According to an order of the Court entered on December 29, 2016, this lawsuit may go forward as a class action. The class certified consists of:

**All California individuals who, at any time beginning four (4) years prior to the filing of the Complaint through the date notice is mailed to the Class (the "Class period"), drove a truck as an "independent contractor" for Defendant.**

**THE COURT HAS NOT RULED ON ANY OF THE CONTENTIONS OF THE PARTIES. THIS NOTICE IS NOT TO BE UNDERSTOOD AS AN EXPRESSION OF ANY OPINION OF THE COURT AS TO THE MERITS OF ANY OF THE CLAIMS OR DEFENSES ASSERTED BY ANY PARTY.**

**I. A BRIEF EXPLANATION OF THE CASE INCLUDING THE BASIC POSITIONS OF THE PARTIES**

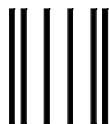
**A. Plaintiff’s Contentions**

Plaintiff alleges that Defendant violated state labor and anti-competition laws by misclassifying California Truck Drivers as Owner/Operators instead of employees.

**B. Defendant’s Contentions**

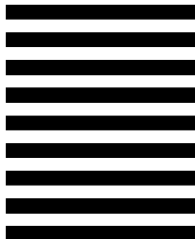
Defendant denies that it misclassified the class members, and instead contends that the drivers are properly classified as independent contractors.

Your rights will be represented by counsel for the Class, unless you wish to separately pay for your own personal legal representation in this matter, which you are entitled to do. If Plaintiffs' counsel is ultimately successful in obtaining a settlement or judgment in favor of the Class, they may be compensated in one of several ways, depending on the Court's orders. The Court might order Defendant to pay the attorneys' fees and costs owed to Plaintiffs' Counsel. Alternatively, the Court might order that a portion of your recovery be used to pay the attorneys' fees and costs of Plaintiffs' Counsel.

**III. THE PROCEDURE FOR YOU TO FOLLOW IN REQUESTING EXCLUSION FROM THE CLASS**

You may be excluded, or Opt-Out, from the Class Action upon completion of the attached Opt-Out form and delivery to the following address: Casillas v. All United Transport, Inc., c/o Simpluris, Inc., P.O. Box 26170, Santa Ana, CA 92799. An Opt-Out form will be deemed timely and you will be excluded from the Class if the request is actually postmarked on or before May 24, 2017. If you validly and timely request to Opt-Out from the Class, you will not be bound by any judgments entered in this Litigation.

If you choose to Opt-Out, you have the opportunity to present any claims that you have by:

- A. Filing your own lawsuit against Defendant; or
- B. Filing your own claim with the appropriate state or federal agencies, with or without an attorney.

You may direct any questions concerning this matter to Plaintiff's Counsel at the address and telephone number noted above.

IF YOU REMAIN A MEMBER OF THE CLASS, YOU WILL BE BOUND BY THE OUTCOME OF THIS CASE, FAVORABLE, OR UNFAVORABLE. That means that if you remain a member of the class, and the case is successful (i.e., there is money to be obtained from the case), you will receive money from this case if you qualify. If the case is unsuccessful, you will not be able to obtain money from the case, or to bring your own personal case at a later time on the matters covered by this lawsuit.

The purpose of this Notice is solely to advise you of this action, your options, and the consequences of your decision. At the present time there have been no settlements or judgments entered against any party. As a result, there is no money or other thing of value to be distributed at this time. You need not make any claim at this time. In the event of any such judgments or settlements, you will receive a separate Notice if you did not exclude yourself from the Class.
