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**JUDGMENT**

Pursuant to the Order Granting the Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Motion for Attorneys’ Fees, Costs, and Class Representative Enhancement Payments, it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** as follows:

1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with, and incorporates by reference the findings of, the Court’s Order Granting the Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Motion for Attorneys’ Fees, Costs, and Class Representative Enhancement Payments (“Order Granting Final Approval”) and the Parties’ Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement and Release (“Settlement Agreement”). Unless otherwise provided herein, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the Settlement Agreement.

2. As provided by the Order Granting Final Approval, all Class Members who did not timely and properly opt out from the Settlement are barred from pursuing, or seeking to reopen, any of the Released Claims, as defined in the Settlement Agreement. Consistent with the definitions provided in the Settlement Agreement, the Settlement Class consists of: All persons who were employed at any of Defendant’s California retail and outlet stores in non-exempt positions at any time during the period from June 4, 2009 to December 22, 2015.

3. Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over the above-captioned action and the parties, including all Class Members, for purposes of enforcing the terms of the Judgment entered herein.

4. This document shall constitute a judgment (and separate document constituting said judgment) for purposes of California Rules of Court, Rule 3.769(h).
