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JUDGMENT

Pursuant to the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement entered on October 26, 2018, it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** as follows:

1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Court's Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and the parties' Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement and Release ("Settlement Agreement") and Amendment to Joint Stipulation of Class Action Settlement and Release ("Amendment to Settlement Agreement"). Unless otherwise provided herein, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the Settlement Agreement.

2. As provided by the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement, all Class Members who did not timely opt-out from the settlement are barred from pursuing, or seeking to reopen, any of the released claims, as defined in the Settlement Agreement. Consistent with the definitions provided in the Settlement Agreement, the settlement class consists of: All current and former non-exempt hourly employees of Defendant employed in California between May 25, 2012 and July 18, 2016.


3. Without affecting the finality of the Judgment, the Court shall retain exclusive and continuing jurisdiction over the above-captioned action and the parties, including all Class Members, for purposes of enforcing the terms of the Judgment entered herein.

4. This document shall constitute a Judgment for purposes of California Rules of Court, Rule 3.769(h).
