1. The Court approves of Exhibit “1”, Plaintiff’s Proposed Order and Exhibit “5”, Defendant’s Proposed Class Notice with modifications, to wit:
 - a. The font size of Defendant’s Proposed Class Notice shall be increased and the postcards placed on a separate page;
 - b. The Class definition shall be the same as the Class definition approved of in the Plaintiff’s Proposed Order (Exhibit “1”);
 - c. Under Section I (B), the sentence shall end after “independent contractors” and the remainder of the sentence shall be deleted;
 - d. Under Section II, the last sentence in that section shall be deleted;
 - e. Under Section III, delete the sentence: “Please note that for those.... Agreements with All United”; and
 - f. The Notice shall be sent in both English and Spanish translations and any associated website shall also provide both translations.
2. Plaintiff is ordered to lodge an original and copy of the revised Notice and the Proposed Order with the Court;
3. The Court scheduled the following dates and events:

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
