

1 The Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement came before this Court, the
2 Honorable William F. Highberger presiding, on ~~September~~^{Oct. 7} 18, 2014. The Court having
3 considered the papers submitted in support of the Motion, HEREBY ORDERS THE
4 FOLLOWING:

5 1. All terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the Stipulation
6 and Settlement Agreement of Class Action Claims (“Stipulation”).

7 2. The Court confirms its conditional certification of the provisional class, in
8 accordance with the Stipulation for the purposes of this settlement only. The class (“Class”) is
9 defined as “all persons who were employed in retail stores in California by Sur La Table, during
10 the period of July 24, 2010 to December 30, 2013.”

11 3. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Action and over all
12 Parties to this Action, including all Class Members.

13 4. The Class Notice, Claim Form, and Exclusion Form provided to the Class conform
14 with the requirements of California Code of Civil Procedure section 382, California Civil Code
15 section 1781, California Rules of Court 3.766 and 3.769, the California and United States
16 Constitutions, and any other applicable law, and constitutes the best notice practicable under the
17 circumstances, by providing individual notice to all Class Members who could be identified
18 through reasonable effort, and by providing due and adequate notice of the proceedings and of the
19 matters set forth therein to the other Class Members. The Class Notice, Claim Form, and
20 Exclusion Form fully satisfied the requirements of due process.

21 5. The Court finds the Stipulation was entered into in good faith, that the settlement
22 is fair, reasonable and adequate, and that the Stipulation satisfies the standards and applicable
23 requirements for final approval of this class action settlement under California law, including the
24 provisions of California Code of Civil Procedure section 382 and California Rules of Court, Rule
25 3.769.

26 6. No Class Members have objected to the terms of the Stipulation.

27 7. ⁸¹80 Class Members have submitted valid Exclusion Forms and have thus been
28 excluded and are not bound by this Settlement Order and Judgment.

1 8. Upon entry of this Settlement Order and Judgment, compensation to the
2 participating members of the Class shall be effected pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation.

3 9. In addition to any recovery that Plaintiff may receive under the Stipulation as a
4 Class Member, and in recognition of the Plaintiff's efforts on behalf of the Class, the Court
5 hereby approves the payment of an enhancement award to the Plaintiff, in the amount of \$1,500.

6 10. The Court approves a Fees and Expense Award to Class Counsel in the sums of
7 \$34,800 for attorneys' fees and of \$14,000 for costs.

8 11. The Court approves and orders payment in the amount of \$18,000 to Simpluris,
9 Inc. for performance of its Administration Costs.

10 12. The Court approves and orders payment in the amount of \$1,750 to the State of
11 California Labor and Workforce Development Agency in compromise of claims under the Labor
12 Code Private Attorneys General Act of 2004 (California Labor Code section 2698 *et seq.*).

13 13. The Parties are ordered to give notice to all Class Members by having Simpluris,
14 Inc. post a copy of this Settlement Order and Judgment to its website in accordance with
15 California Rule of Court 3.771(b).

16 14. Upon the Effective Date, Plaintiff and Class Members, except the excluded
17 individuals referenced in paragraph 7 of this Settlement Order and Judgment, shall have, by
18 operation of this Settlement Order and Judgment, fully, finally and forever released, relinquished,
19 and discharged Defendant and the Released Parties from all Released Claims as defined by the
20 terms of the Stipulation.

21 15. Upon the Effective Date, all Class Members, except the excluded individuals
22 referenced in paragraph 7 of this Settlement Order and Judgment, shall be and are hereby
23 permanently barred and enjoined from the institution or prosecution of any and all of the claims
24 released under the terms of the Stipulation.

25 16. Upon completion of administration of the Stipulation, the Parties shall file a
26 declaration stating that all claims have been paid and that the terms of the Stipulation have been
27 completed.


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1 17. This "Judgment" is intended to be a final disposition of the Action in its entirety,
2 and is intended to be immediately appealable.

3 18. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters related to the
4 administration and consummation of the Stipulation, and any and all claims, asserted in, arising
5 out of, or related to the subject matter of the Action, including but not limited to all matters
6 related to the Stipulation and the determination of all controversies relating thereto.
