**ORDER GRANTING THE PARTIES' JOINT MOTION TO APPROVE ADDITIONAL
CLAIMS VALIDATION PROCESS AND JOINT MOTION TO SEAL**

This matter comes before the Court on the Parties' Joint Motion to Seal (dkt. 84) and Joint Motion to Approve Additional Claims Validation Process (dkt. 86). The Court having reviewed the papers and arguments of all interested parties and having held a hearing on the joint motions on August 29, 2024, and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, DECREED, AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Parties' Joint Motion to Seal (dkt. 84) is GRANTED. Pursuant to Local Rule 26.2, the Clerk of the Court is directed to file and maintain the Joint Motion to Approve Additional Claims Validation Process and the Declaration of Amy Lechner of Simpluris, Inc. Regarding Claims Validations (dkt. 85) under seal. Access to the sealed documents shall be restricted to the Court and the Parties unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

2. The Parties' Joint Motion to Approve Additional Claims Validation Process (dkts. 85, 86) is GRANTED. Having taken notice of the revised information provided by the Settlement Administrator and the updated data regarding accepted and rejected claims (dkts. 85-1, 86-1), the Court approves the Settlement Administrator's proposed plan for addressing fraud

and potential fraud identified during settlement administration, as fully described in the Parties' Joint Motion to Approve Additional Claims Validation Process (dkts. 85, 86 at ¶¶ 5-7).

3. The Settlement Administrator shall distribute all Settlement Payments on or before October 18, 2024.
